We have exceptional sports pitches and facilities in our beautiful 25 acres of grounds including our adventure playground which is full of children climbing, swinging and balancing at break times.

Music & performance

Everyone takes part in music and drama. There's a weekly music class and singing practice in every child's syllabus. An impressive 80 per cent of children choose to have individual music lessons; with over 300 lessons in progress each week!

Music is part of the fabric of school life. There are orchestras, a wind band, jazz band, singing groups, choirs and musical productions going on throughout the term. Parents enjoy our popular lunchtime concerts. Some children are involved with professional productions such as the Grange Festival. We have been nominated for the 'Best Music Department' at the Music Education Awards and enjoy an excellent reputation for the quality of our performances and the musicians that we send out into the world.

Our music teachers inspire great things by taking time to explore personal tastes, to find an instrument, group or song that appeals and making music enjoyable. With our combination of talented teachers, well-resourced teaching rooms and generous rehearsal facilities, Twyford is a wonderful platform for music in its many forms.

Treading the boards in one of our many school plays is something that every pupil will experience. If you're less inclined to be under the spotlight, there's plenty of opportunity to operate one as part of our production team. One of the most popular events is our 'Twyford's Got Talent' show which draws laughter and awe in equal measure – it's amazing what children can do! Year 8 children take part in a 'Shakespeare Week' run by professional actors and culminating in their own production. Drama is part of the school timetable and all children are offered tuition for the English Speaking Board and LAMDA exams.

Art & design

A light, spacious and purpose built studio is home to our Art & Design Department. Art encourages children to experiment with lots of different media including sculpture, ceramics, modelling, screen printing, painting and drawing. The quality of work on display is often compared to GCSE portfolios.

Children are encouraged to explore the things that interest them. They are taught artistic skills to develop their abilities and learn about proportion, the use of colour, balance and perspective. From Year 6, children can join extra Art Club where they enjoy exploring new ideas and further developing their individual styles and interests.

Our Design and Technology Department is located in the same building as the Art Department. Children develop a range of skills across a variety of projects, as well as developing their own dexterity through traditional hand-crafts.

Designing the things you will then make becomes a passion for many children, working individually and as part of a team. One of our greatest team challenges has been the design and build of an eco-powered go-kart to enter, along with a driver, into the Greenpower Challenge at Goodwood race track.



Flexible boarding

Boarding is an integral part of Twyford life. Rooms are comfortable and bright. There's a friendly family environment, and always plenty to do. Boarding is flexible, so whether it's a one or two night stopover, the occasional sleepover to attend a club, or weekly boarding we're happy to work around you. All our teachers help with a boarding evening. There's a strong sense of community. Friendships are made across all age groups and it's an opportunity for children to enjoy getting to know staff outside the busy school day.

Everyone looks out for each other and our core values of respect, honesty, kindness and responsibility are evident in every aspect of boarding life. It's also great fun with lots of activities to enjoy including barbeques, movie nights with cupcakes, our giant games of hide-and-seek in the school grounds in the summer or our legendary dodgeball games when the nights draw in.

Boarding is a good way to prepare children for their senior schools and to nurture a sense of independence and confidence away from home. Our Matrons are always there to give support, lend a sympathetic ear and tend to any illness. We have overseas Gap Assistants, who are naturally popular with the children and lend their energies to a full house life. Children build friendships for life and enjoy spending time with their friends in a safe, enjoyable and homely environment.

The great outdoors

Healthy body, healthy mind is a philosophy that hasn't changed over many decades at Twyford. Within our grounds we enjoy incredible adventure facilities and woodlands where children can explore the natural world.

Our woodland shelter is popular as an outdoor learning centre, the location for evening stories and a gathering point for woodland projects. Outdoor learning and adventure is an important part of a child's education; it helps develop an awareness of the world around them and understand the delicate relationship we have with nature.

Outdoor life is also about having fun, keeping fit and just enjoying being young. We often cook around the fire pit, making pitta bread or toasting marshmallows together. Children learn bushcraft skills and how to enjoy the great outdoors safely.

The children participate in a wide programme of outdoor pursuits that include residential adventure training trips that extend in both length and skill base as the children advance through the School. Children experience climbing, orienteering, sailing and canoeing trips throughout their time at school as well as our Year 6 trip to a chateau in Normandy, France.
